# **Greenrivers Hotjar Plugin**

The Hotjar Plugin is an extension for Grav CMS.

It allows You to add hotjar script for collect and tracking data.

### Installation

Installing the Hotjar plugin can be done in one of three ways: - GPM (Grav Package Manager) - manual method - admin method

### **GPM Installation (Preferred)**

To install the plugin via the GPM, through your system's terminal (also called the command line), navigate to the root of your Grav-installation, and enter:

bin/gpm install hotjar

This will install the Hotjar plugin into your /user/plugins -directory within Grav. Its files can be found under /your/site/grav/user/plugins/hotjar.

#### **Manual Installation**

To install the plugin manually, download the zip-version of this repository and unzip it under /your/site/grav/user/plugins. Then rename the folder to hotjar. You can find these files on GitHub or via GetGrav.org.

You should now have all the plugin files under

```
/your/site/grav/user/plugins/hotjar
```

NOTE: This plugin is a modular component for Grav which may require other plugins to operate, please see its blueprints.yaml-file on GitHub.

#### **Admin Plugin**

If you use the Admin Plugin, you can install the plugin directly by browsing the Plugins -menu and clicking on the Add button.

### Configuration

Before configuring this plugin, you should copy the user/plugins/hotjar/hotjar.yaml to user/config/plugins/hotjar.yaml and only edit that copy.

Here is the default configuration and an explanation of available options:

```
enabled: true
hjsv: 6
```

Note that if you use the Admin Plugin, a file with your configuration named hotjar.yaml will be saved in the user/config/plugins/ -folder once the configuration is saved in the Admin.

### Usage

Properly working of Hotjar integration requires Hotjar ID.

Hotjar snippet version is set to the current Hotjar version.

Clear the cache after updating the configuration.
